

Ray Bonneville

Join the Lethbridge Folk Club as we proudly present Ray Bonneville with Richie Lawrence and opener Eric Braun.

Acclaimed raconteur **Ray Bonneville** strips his bluesy Americana down to its essentials and steeps it in the hu mid grooves of the South, creating a compelling poetry of hard living and deep feeling.

Jim Withers (Montreal Gazette) describes his sound as "folk-roots gumbo... a languid Mississippi Delta groov e, seasoned with smooth, weathered vocals and a propulsive harmonica wheeze." Whether performing solo or f ronting a band, playing electric or acoustic guitar, Bonneville allows space between notes that adds potency to e very chord, lick, and lyric. Thom Jurek (Allmusic.com) remarks, "With darkness and light fighting for dominan ce... he's stripped away every musical excess to let the songs speak for themselves."

Often called a "song and groove man," Bonneville has lived the life of the itinerant artist. From his native Queb ec, he moved to Boston at age twelve, where he learned English and picked up piano and guitar. Later, he served in Vietnam and earned a pilot's license in Colorado before living in Alaska, Seattle, and Paris. Six years in New Orleans infused his musical sensibilities with the region's culture and rhythms. And then, a close call while pilo ting a seaplane proved pivotal: After two decades working as a studio musician, playing rowdy rooms with blue s bands, and living hard, Bonneville's lifetime of hard-won experience coalesced into an urge to write his own music.

Ray recorded his first album, *On the Main*, in 1992. He's since released nine albums, including his October 20 23 release, *On The Blind Side*, earned wide critical and popular acclaim, and won an enthusiastic following in t he U.S., Canada, and Europe. His awards include a prestigious Juno, the Canadian equivalent of a Grammy, for his 1999 album, *Gust of Wind*. In 2012, Ray won the solo/duet category in the Blues Foundation's Internationa 1 Blues Challenge. His post-Katrina ode, "*I Am the Big Easy*," earned the International Folk Alliance's 2009 So ng of the Year Award, placed number one on Folk Radio's list of most-played songs of 2008, and was recently

covered by Jennifer Warnes for the BMG label.

Other notable artists who have recorded his songs include Ronnie Hawkins ("Foolish") and Slaid Cleaves ("Ru n Jolee Run"). Ray has shared the bill with blues heavyweights Muddy Waters, B.B. King, Dr. John, J.J. Cale, an d Robert Cray, and has guested on albums by Mary Gauthier, Gurf Morlix, Eliza Gilkyson, Ray Wylie Hubbard, and other prominent musicians. He has performed at renowned venues around the world, including South by So uthwest, Folk Alliance, and Montreal International Jazz Festival, and plays over 100 shows per year across the U.S., Canada, and Europe. When not on the road, Ray divides his time between homes in Goulais River, Ontari o and Austin, Texas.

Hailing from Southern Alberta, **Eric Braun** blend s the storytelling essence of country with the raw e nergy of rock, creating a sound that resonates deep ly with listeners. Since picking up the guitar at 15, Eric has honed his craft and developed a unique vo ice in the music scene.

In 2017, he released his debut album, "Clear Your Mind," showcasing his knack for poignant lyrics a nd melodic hooks. Following that, his 2019 single , "(Please Don't) Give Me Hope," further establis hed his presence, drawing inspiration from musica l icons like Chris Stapleton, John Mayer, and Keith Urban.

With a recent signing to Blue Willow Entertainme nt, Eric is poised to take his career to the next leve l. He's currently in the studio working on a full-le ngth album set to release next year, and he's gearin g up for a tour in summer 2025. As he continues t o evolve as an artist, Eric Braun remains committe d to sharing his authentic sound and connecting wi th audiences everywhere.
